III. Hy Tek Issues

Teams must upgrade their TM software to the 5.0 release if they have not done so already. This will allow easier interface and downloads of your roster into your software from our new online registration system. Teams should update their Meet Manager and Team Manager software now. This can be done for FREE by clicking on the “Check for Updates” option in your software. While Hy Tek has come out with Meet Manager 3.0, we are advising teams to NOT upgrade at this time, the cost is not justified by the new product.

IV. Rankings (see attachment)

Rankings are calculated as a function of how many dual meet wins and Championship points you had and the number of swimmers on your roster. No team can move up more than 6 ranking places in one year. Teams may however drop an unlimited number of places in one season. Your schedule is comprised of meets against teams within 6 ranking places above or below your team. The schedule will be balanced with meets against 2 or 3 teams above your ranking and 2 or e teams below your ranking. The “super-division” teams for 2010 are as follows: Aberdeen, Alpharetta, Brookwood Hills, Chastain, Glen Abbey, Grand Cascades, Hanover West, and Windward. They will swim some, but likely not all of their meets against each other.

VI. Rule Changes and Proposals for 2010 Atlanta Swim Association

Full body suits (Speedo Lazer Racer, Blue 70, Tyr, etc...) will not be allowed in ASA meets. The suit restrictions are as follows:

Boys suits are limited to a jammer or brief design that can extend no further than the knee and cannot cover the upper torso or arms. Girl’s suits may not extend below the knee and cannot extend past the shoulders in coverage. All suits must be made from a “permeable” material and cannot compress the swimmer’s body.

VII. Online Registration

- Swimmers must register for the league using our online registration process. This can be done by visiting atlantaswimming.com and selecting the online registration link. All swimmers for each team must be registered by May 1st or will be subject to a late registration fee of \$20 (instead of \$17). Swimmers registering after June 1 will have to pay \$25 to swim.
- Teams that have a significant number of unpaid swimmers as of the entry deadline for the league championship may not be allowed to participate in that meet.
- Teams will be able to view their team’s registration information via secure link to active.com’s website. Each team will get a user name and password to log into the system and view real time registration info for their team.
- Teams with unpaid swimmers will be responsible for all unpaid fees by Aug 1.

- Teams will be able to download their team's roster by using File – Import – Team Signup Online (Active) and then select your team. The User Name and the password can be e mailed to you by request.

VIII. League Awards and Scholarship Program

Educational Scholarship Awards

Once again, ASA is pleased to offer two \$500 scholarships to be awarded to an eligible graduating senior, male and female, planning to continue their education after high school. Our goal is to encourage our swimmers, help promote the positive benefits of swimming, the importance of community involvement and offer educational support.

Eligibility will be based on the following selection criteria:

- Must be a graduating Senior and registered in the ASA swim league
- A Letter of Recommendation must be submitted to the league for the swimmer to be considered
- Points scored in the ASA Championship Meet (individual & relays events)

The scholarship will be based on the combination of the above criteria and will be presented at the conclusion of the ASA Championship.

Team Sportsmanship Award

Once again ASA will recognize teams for what we embrace most, good sportsmanship. This award is based on nominations from your fellow teams. This team will be recognized during the divisional session of the ASA Championship meet for the winning team.

IX. Next Meetings

- Rules and Schedule Meeting - Teams receive updated rules and schedules. Review of ASA Rules will be done at this meeting. (Tentative Date: mid April, 7 p.m. locations TBD)
- May Meeting – Teams receive ribbons and paperwork for the season. An optional review of dual meet procedure will be done at this meeting. (Wednesday, May 19 at 7:00 p.m. at Marist pool for all teams)
- Hy Tek Training -- Training for Hy Tek Team and Meet Manager to be held at Marist in the 2nd floor classroom of Centennial Gym. (Dates TBD) the 10 am sessions will be for advanced users with some experience with the software, the 3 pm sessions are for new users of Hy Tek.
- Coaches Meeting - A mandatory coaches meeting for rules review that at least one member from each team's staff must attend one of the offered sessions. (Date: Sunday, May 16 at 1:00 p.m. at Marist Pool or Sunday May 23 at 1:00 p.m. at Marist Pool). We will offer an enhanced stroke clinic for coaches at the May 16 meeting only.
